HOUSE BILL 2973

AN ACT to make appropriations for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the state government for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2023, and July 1, 2024, in the administration, operation and maintenance of the legislative, executive and judicial branches of the various departments, institutions, offices and agencies of the state; for certain state aid and obligations; for capital outlay, for the service of the public debt, for emergency and contingency; to repeal certain appropriations and any acts inconsistent herewith; to provide provisional continuing appropriations; and to establish certain provisions, limitations and restrictions under which appropriations may be obligated and expended. This act makes appropriations for the purposes described above for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2023, and July 1, 2024.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. That appropriations hereinafter set out are hereby made for the purpose of defraying the expenses of state government for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, in the administration, operation and maintenance of the legislative, executive and judicial branches of the various departments, institutions, offices and agencies of the state, and for certain state aid and obligations and for capital outlay; for the service of the public debt, and for emergency and contingency, all according to the following schedule:

Item 48. To the Tennessee Film, Entertainment and Music Commission from departmental revenues received by and interest earnings allocated to the commission. This appropriation is subject to approval by the Commissioner of Finance and Administration.

Item 76. To the Department of Economic and Community Development, Tennessee Film and Television Incentive Fund, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-3-4903(e), the Commissioner of Finance and Administration is authorized to carry forward unexpended balances of any appropriations made for the incentive fund, and the unexpended grant balances of the Tennessee Entertainment Commission.

SECTION 56. If any provision of this act or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, then the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of the act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to that end, the provisions of this act are severable.

SECTION 57. This act takes effect July 1, 2024, the public welfare requiring it; provided, however, that any provision of this act which authorizes prior or immediate expenditures and any section or item which specifies an immediate effective date takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
